Thank you to everyone who ate at City BBQ in December for our Restaurant Fundraiser! A total of \$204.00 was earned for our school! This money, along with funds from a School Safety Grant we were recently awarded and proceeds from our upcoming Art Show Event, will be used for additional Security Upgrades including additional cameras, 2 more keypads to make playground access easier for our staff, and replacing door 9.

## \*Registration for the September 2024-May 2025 School Year will begin in Late January and Early February.

More information, including tuition rates, programs, and confirmed dates of registration will be posted around MLK Day. (Dates currently set are pending budget approval). We do not plan to change any of our programs or schedules, but there will be a small increase in tuition rates for next school year. Start thinking about your fall plans now!

Registration will be online again this year. The link for each round will be distributed to each eligible group by email prior to date and will be live beginning at 8am on the applicable date of registration. The public registration link may be posted to our website and Facebook page a few hours prior to public registration beginning, but will not work until 8am on

January 27th. If your child is not currently enrolled, please contact me to ensure you are on the correct distribution list. \*Registration dates are tentative, pending budget approval.

You may be contemplating which program is the best fit for your child for the 24-25 school year. In Mid-January, each preschooler will receive a "Fall Recommendation Form" which lets you know our professional recommendation for fall enrollment as of today. If you would like a mid-year conference at that time, please let us know. We will have a formal Parent-Teacher Conference for all students on March 20th and 21st. depending on your teacher's schedule. There are no classes on conference days.

If you need a statement for tuition paid August-December 2023 for tax deduction purposes, please let me know. Statements will be sent home in your child's backpack by January 31.

**Inclement Weather Plan:** From time to time, we may need to close or alter our schedule due to inclement weather. Please tune to WHIOTV and watch for any closings to be listed under "A Great Start Preschool." I also plan to update our voicemail for the day, post to Facebook, and likely send out an email to all if our schedule is changed. It is always best to call ahead or check one of the methods above to make sure we are open on normal schedule on days of inclement weather.

\*We plan to go outside if it is above 32 degrees and fairly dry, so please send your child with appropriate coat/hats/mittens, labeled with your child's name. Please practice with your child putting on their own mittens/gloves and coat (and zipping independently).

- \* Please check the *main compartment* of your child's backpack daily for notes from the office or teacher, artwork, etc.
- \*Have something to send into the preschool? You can put it in the drop box to the right of the preschool office, or the drop box outside door 10 above the keypad, or send it in the main compartment of your child's backpack, which our Aides will check daily. There is also a basket for paperwork on my desk.
